Alison Stanton is a ceramic artist and potter. She creates works from rolled slabs and uses a wheel to throw pottery.

Alison grew up in Pittsburgh where a high school art teacher sparked her interest in pottery. Later, she lived in Virginia where she worked at a ceramic co-op. Her colleagues there greatly influenced her work. Today, working in Nova Scotia, she finds inspiration in the local landscape, as well as in its flora and fauna. Alison considers her exhibit at the Osprey Arts Centre to be one of her most significant accomplishments. The solo show featured mostly slab work imprinted with plants. Her work as an artist in schools through the ArtsSmart program, in which she works to bring art into the school curriculum, is also important to her.
