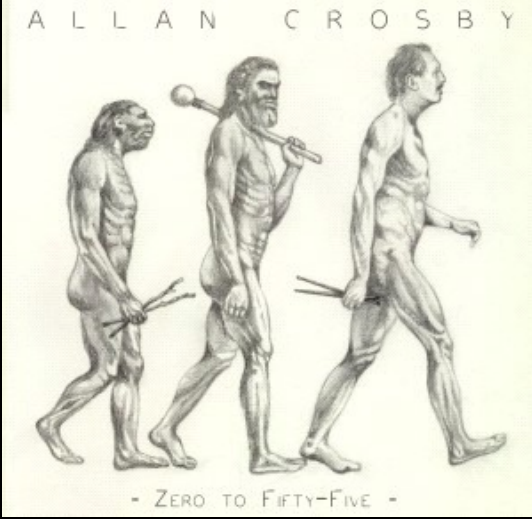


# Allan Crosby
