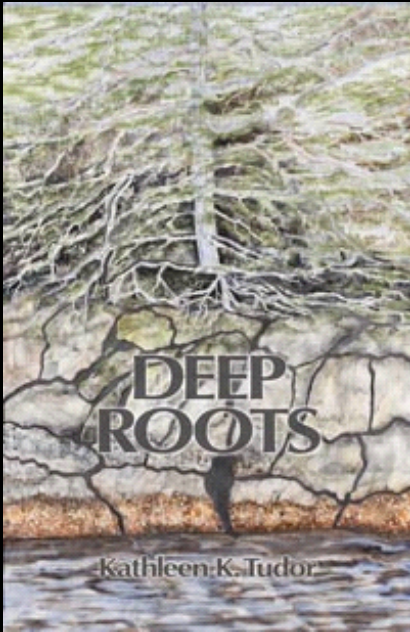


Kathleen Tudor
